Valentine Treat Event summary (14 Feb 2018)

Menu remained the same (pannacotta/biscotti) as the 2017 event. About 40 people were served during break time between guest speaker and business meeting. The fee was \$3/person, money was taken at the door and small pink slips of paper were given in exchange for payment. For seed money, \$75 in small bills (50 \$1, 5 \$5 bills) was available but most everyone had exact change! A small basket was at the beginning of the serving line for people to deposit their slip of paper before picking up their bowl of pannacotta.

Mary Jeanne Richards purchased red plastic bowls for the pannacotta and they were washed for re-use at the next event. All the yogurt containers were brought to the meeting to allow any extra pannacotta to be sold to members for \$5 after the serving was completed. A red tablecloth covered a table placed in the corner by the galley area for the platters of biscotti and bowls of fresh blueberries. Pannecotta was served from the galley window opening in $\frac{3}{4}$ cup servings, which seemed to be adequate.

If this event is done in 2019, seven (7) batches of pannacotta would be adequate. We had made extra because we were expecting more attendees due to the topic of the guest speaker (tsunami history and preparation). Additionally, two double batches of biscotti would be enough and three (3) clamshell containers of blueberries (18 oz each) would be adequate for the event.

With the cold weather we were having, the large coffee pot was set up on a table along the wall and 45 cups of coffee were made which was adequate for the crowd. Overall, it was a successful event and we even made a profit!
